PATRIOT GUARD

Just the first half of August was busy. That's all I can report on because I am going out of town. We had some happy events and a lot of sad ones. The return of Scott Speicher's remains was a mixed event. It was sad that he was not alive but good that the family had closure.

I will leave the detailed report to ALR Chapter 137. I would just say that the Patriot Guard worked very diligently with the DOD, the Navy, the Police and others to get arrangements made. Once ready the event was made open to all. On Aug 3rd the remains of a Marine who was killed in the "Sandbox" were returned to NAS Jax. The Patriot Guard was there to greet the body and to show support for the family. As we left the flight line to escort the body off base, people lined both sides of the "Main Drag" almost all the way to the gate. We broke up about noon.

Then there was a call to meet out at JIA at 4:30 that same afternoon. The original plan was to welcome just one returning soldier. As it turned out 2 flights were coming in with returning soldiers on them. So instead of just one, four hero's were welcomed home.

Another major event occurred in August. Viet Nam veteran Michael Gares died and was buried in California. The original plan was to FedEx the burial flag to his daughter who lives in Palm Coast, Fl. The PGR would not have this. So plans were made and a Pony Express Ride was set up. When the mother heard what the PGR was doing she dropped the phone and almost fainted with joy. The flag left California on Aug 4th and began its journey across country. It was at all times in the possession of the PGR and only stopped at night. The flag arrived in Jacksonville on Aug 8th. On Aug 9th motorcycles and escort "cages" met at Cecil Commerce Center. After brief ceremonies we departed on the trip to Palm Coast and were joined along the way by other bikes. Post 137 adjutant Ken Foldy joined in the escort. The flag was presented to the daughter at 2:30PM. In all, over a thousand PGR members took part in this Pony Express escort mission.

The Special Pension for Veteran's Aid and Attendance pays up to \$1,644.00 a month, \$19,736.00 annually towards assisted living, nursing homes or in home care for veterans 65 and older who served 90 days and one day during wartime stateside or overseas. Veterans and their spouses can receive up to \$23,396.00 annually and spouses of deceased veterans \$12,681.00.

When the forms are completed it usually takes four to six months to receive these benefits.
